Parish News:

With the arrival of Fr Michael on 17th August, clergy responsibilities are being reallocated namely:

- Fr John will be assuming additional work as Chaplain to HMP Peterborough with additional hours. He will also be taking over the chaplaincy of ECH from Fr Bruce at St Oswald's in anticipation of the hospital merger this coming November. Fr John will continue to head up Baptismal Catechesis in the parish.
- Fr Michael will take on chaplaincy at St John Fisher High School with Sister Virna. He will also be responsible for parish Eucharistic Ministers, their training and co-ordinating visits to the sick and housebound.
- Fr David will continue as a Governor at SJF and Priest Member of the Diocesan Safeguarding Commission. Fr David has also accepted to join the PCC's Strategic Board for Homelessness and the Strategic Board for the Prevention of Violent Extremism. Fr David will continue heading up Catechesis in the parish – in particular Marriage Preparation and Confirmation.
- Deacon John Bedford will continue to lead on the 'Come and See' RCIA programme.
- Deacon Claudio will continue to be the parish link with the Italian community

Fr Eric Willett in March remains ill – All Souls has generously offered to cover there till September 12th

With the arrival of 2 Italian Priests based at All Souls – we have also offered to celebrate and restore the Sunday 10.30am Mass at the Italian Mission till September 5th.
